Pope Francis made a heartfelt appeal for peace
in Ukraine at his public audience in the Vatican
on February 23rd, as the situation continued to
deteriorate between Russia and Ukraine. He
appealed to the consciences of “those with
political responsibility” and “all the parties
involved” to “refrain from any action that would
cause even more suffering to the people,
destabilizing coexistence between nations and
bringing international law into disrepute.”
