Lenten Activities for Immaculate Conception – 2024

- 1) **Ash Wednesday, February 14th, Mass at 8AM & Mass at 5:30PM, NO Soup & Bread Supper on this date.**
- 2) **On the next 5 Wednesdays, Feb. 21, 28, March 6, 13, 20: there will be a 5:30PM Eucharistic Adoration followed by Soup & Bread Supper.**
- 3) **A sign-up sheet is on the table in the vestibule for volunteers to bring soup and bread to these 5 Wednesday evening services.**
- 4) **The regular Wednesday morning 8AM Mass will continue through Lent.**
- 5) **On Friday mornings there will be the 8AM Mass as usual, February 16, 23, March 1, 8, 15, 22; followed by Stations of the Cross.**
- 6) **Holy Thursday: March 28, 6:00PM, Mass of the Lord's Supper.**
- 7) **Good Friday Service: March 29, at 1PM: the Passion and Death of our Lord.**
